Vote was taken and members of the court unanimously voted yes. Motion carried.

8. PAY CLAIMS AND LINE-ITEM ADJUSTMENTS AS REQUESTED BY THE COUNTY AUDITOR.

Motion was made by Commissioner Mahaffey, seconded by Commissioner Ortega to pay claims 1-82 and line-item adjustments. Vote was taken and members of the court unanimously voted yes. Motion carried.

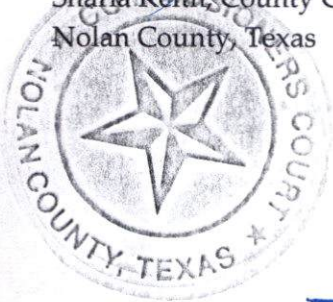
9. ADJOURN.


