

Notice of Tax Revenue Increase

The County of Nolan conducted public hearings on August 27, 2012 and September 10, 2012 on a proposal to increase the total tax revenues of the County of Nolan from properties on the tax roll in the preceding year by 7.99 percent.

The total tax revenue raised last year at last year's tax rate of \$0.423023 for each \$100 of taxable value was \$ 6,784,085.11.

The total tax revenue proposed to be raised this year at the proposed tax rate of \$0.394635 for each \$100 of taxable value, excluding tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year is \$7,320,453.52.

The total tax revenue proposed to be raised this year at the proposed tax rate of \$0.394635 for each \$100 of taxable value, including tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year is \$7,681,271.70.

The Nolan County Commissioners of County of Nolan is scheduled to vote on the tax rate that will result in that tax increase at a public meeting to be held on September 17, 2012 at Commissioners Court, Nolan County Courthouse, Sweetwater, Texas at 9:00 am.
