



Notice of Public Hearing on Tax Increase

The NOLAN COUNTY will hold two public hearings on a proposal to increase total tax revenues from properties on the tax roll in the preceding tax year by 8 percent. Your individual taxes may increase at a greater or lesser rate, or even decrease, depending on the change in the taxable value of your property in relation to the change in taxable value of all other property and the tax rate is adopted.

The first public hearing will be held on 08/22/2011 09:00 AM at Nolan County Courtroom, Nolan County Courthouse.

The second public hearing will be held on 09/12/2011 09:00 AM at Nolan County Courtroom, Nolan County Courthouse.

The average taxable value of a residence homestead in last year was \$41732 . Based on last years tax rate of \$0.37536 per \$100 of taxable value, the amount of taxes imposed last year on the average home was \$156.65.

The average taxable value of a residence homestead in this year is \$43293. If the governing body adopts the effective tax rate for this year of \$0.391688 per \$100 of taxable value, the amount of taxes imposed this year on the average home would be \$169.58.

If the governing body adopts the proposed tax rate of \$ 0.423023 per \$100 of taxable value, the amount of taxes imposed this year on the average home would be \$183.14 .
