It is ORDERED that all other causes within the jurisdiction of the 1st Multicounty Court at Law in which either Lance Hall (Texas Bar No. 08763500) or Michael Hall (Texas Bar No. 24057881) appear as counsel shall be, and are hereby, transferred to the 32nd Judicial District Court in Nolan County, Texas.
