

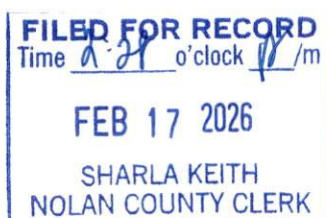

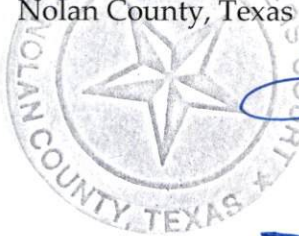
12. ADJOURN.


