**14. ADJOURN.**

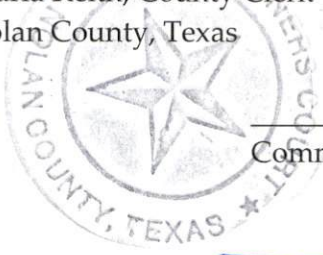


